### C.I.T. PROGRAM

The Counselor in Training Program is offered to children ages 13-15. The youngsters will participate in daily camper activities and ascertain valuable leadership skills as they learn daily camp counselor responsibilities.

The cost is \$265.00 per week for General & Sports Camp. \$575 (week 9 only \$290) for Theatre Arts Camp, 2 week blocks.

### CAMP HOURS

World Gym Day Camp hours are from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM. Drop off and pick up are in the multi-sport arena.

### BEHAVIOR POLICY

There is a behavior contract pertaining to appropriate camp conduct and discipline which will be given to each parent/guardian.

### AFTER CARE

To allow parents an opportunity to complete their busy work day, World Gym Day Camp offers an After Care Program from 3:30 to 6:00 PM each day. We also offer Before Care from 7:30-8:30 AM. Parents may register anywhere from one to five days per week. The cost of After Care is based on pick up time (see below). A snack will be provided. There is no discount on After Care.

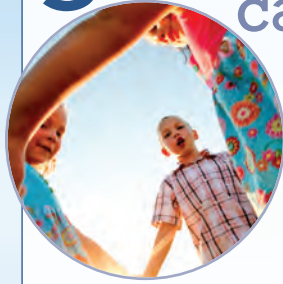
**MARK PASSIATORE**

# theatre arts camp

Campers perform for their family and friends every two weeks during weeks 1-8 with productions including original works and well-known plays. Children **MUST** attend this program for a two week session during weeks 1-8 in order to prepare for the performances. (i.e. weeks 1&2, weeks 3&4, weeks 5&6, or weeks 7&8) However, campers may attend for a single week during Week 9 **ONLY** when Theater Arts will prepare for the Camp Talent Show which will be on Thursday of Week 9.

## GROUPS
